 Matthew 25:31-46 The sheep and the goats

Here are some ideas and activities you could do as a family



Investigate

Are there issues in the world where you know people are not treated fairly, for example, human trafficking, homelessness, poverty, mental health and wellbeing support, sexism, racism?

Do some research and prepare a presentation, poster, or video message to share with your church community either online or when you are meeting together back in your church building. Make sure you include some tips for how other people can get involved and help. Could you ask another family to do some research about a different issue in your community?



Share

Sadly, many children around the world don't experience the same rights as we do, for example, clean water, shelter, an education and more. As a family consider how you could make a difference to one child's life by sponsoring them.



Hear

You may have already donated items to a food bank at this time. If you haven't already, why not ring the foodbank and ask what they really need and donate that. You could organise a collection in your street.



Bake

Make snack bags for those who are homeless in your community. Find a local charity who is supporting them and pass your snack bags to them to give out.

Bake cookies, cakes, sweeties, for your community and spread the love of Jesus by putting a message of hope on the packaging.



Write

Raise money for The Salvation Army, or for a charity close to you, by hosting an online quiz night as a family. Each member of the family could prepare a round or two on a topic which interests them.
